Who can apply?

Students 19+ who are currently enrolled in BA, MA or PhD programs, based in Europe, in the following fields: ethnology, cultural anthropology, archaeology, architecture, applied arts, visual arts, history of art, history, management in culture, interdisciplinary studies, culture studies or any other field of social sciences and arts.

The Summer School will be held in English, which means that all participants should be fluent in this language.

Where is the summer school taking place?

The Summer School will be held in Viminacium Archaeological Park in eastern Serbia. Viminacium was a military camp and major city (provincial capital) of the Roman province of Moesia Superior. Nowadays, this archaeological park is center of many archaeological, educational and cultural events. Its value and uniqueness is t also by relevant international institutions.
