Hear ye, hear ye,

SECRA (Students and Early Career Researchers in Archaeology) is an international conference founded in 2026 by archaeology students at the University of Zagreb.

SECRA was established **to bring together young archaeologists** at all levels of study and beyond, including **undergraduate, graduate, and postgraduate students**, as well as **early career researchers**. Our intention is to provide young archaeologists with the **opportunity to present their current research across various archaeological disciplines** (e.g., Prehistoric, Classical, Roman Provincial, Late Antique, Medieval, Postmedieval, and Modern Archaeology, Archaeological Science, Methodology, Underwater Archaeology, Speleoarchaeology).

We aim to encourage collaboration among young archaeologists, promote the exchange of ideas and knowledge, and enhance participants' academic and professional skills.

The conference will be held on 14 - 15th May 2026 at the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, University of Zagreb, Croatia.

THE ABSTRACT SUBMISSION DEADLINE IS FRIDAY, APRIL 17TH, 2026.

There is **NO REGISTRATION FEE**.

The official language of the conference is **English**.

For international or faraway participants, there will be an option to **participate in the conference VIRTUALLY**.

Abstracts can be submitted in the following format:

- Title of the abstract (maximum 20 words)
- Names of the authors
- Institutional affiliation
- 200-350 words for text
- 3-5 keywords

Participants may choose one or both presentation formats:

1. **Oral presentation:** 15-minute **podium presentations** for students and early career researchers to showcase their research and receive feedback in a follow-up discussion
2. **Poster presentation:** posters presented in a **physical format** (size A0) that provide students and early career researchers with a visually rich way to showcase their research to the interested public during allocated sessions
